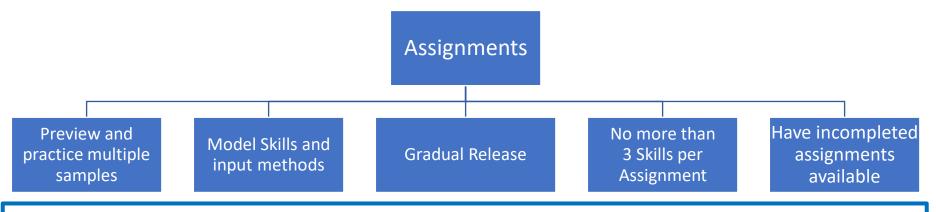

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Best Practices



- Preview multiple versions of the skill and VIEW THE ANSWERS before assigning to your students.
