

GMM Goal Achieving Lesson Plan

getM^{ORE}math!

Goal:

Motivate students by showcasing their GMM points.

Materials:

- Devices (Chromebooks/iPads/computers)
- Thermometer Poster (click [here](#) for directions on printing poster size)
- Possible rewards: homework passes, party, movie day, business donated gift cards, listen to music day, etc.

Lesson:

1. Choose a timeframe for students to earn points. (2 weeks, 1 month, 1 marking period, etc.)
2. Designate the number of points the class or grade level needs to earn during this time frame. This can become a competition between classes or grade levels.
3. At the end of every week, check the number of points students have earned. Using Points History, find the totals for each class. Adjust the date range for Points History as needed.

4. Color the thermometer to showcase the current total.
5. Repeat each week (or day) until the goal time frame has expired.
6. At the end of the time frame, reward the winning class or grade. If the entire class or grade reaches the goal amount, encourage administrators to get involved.



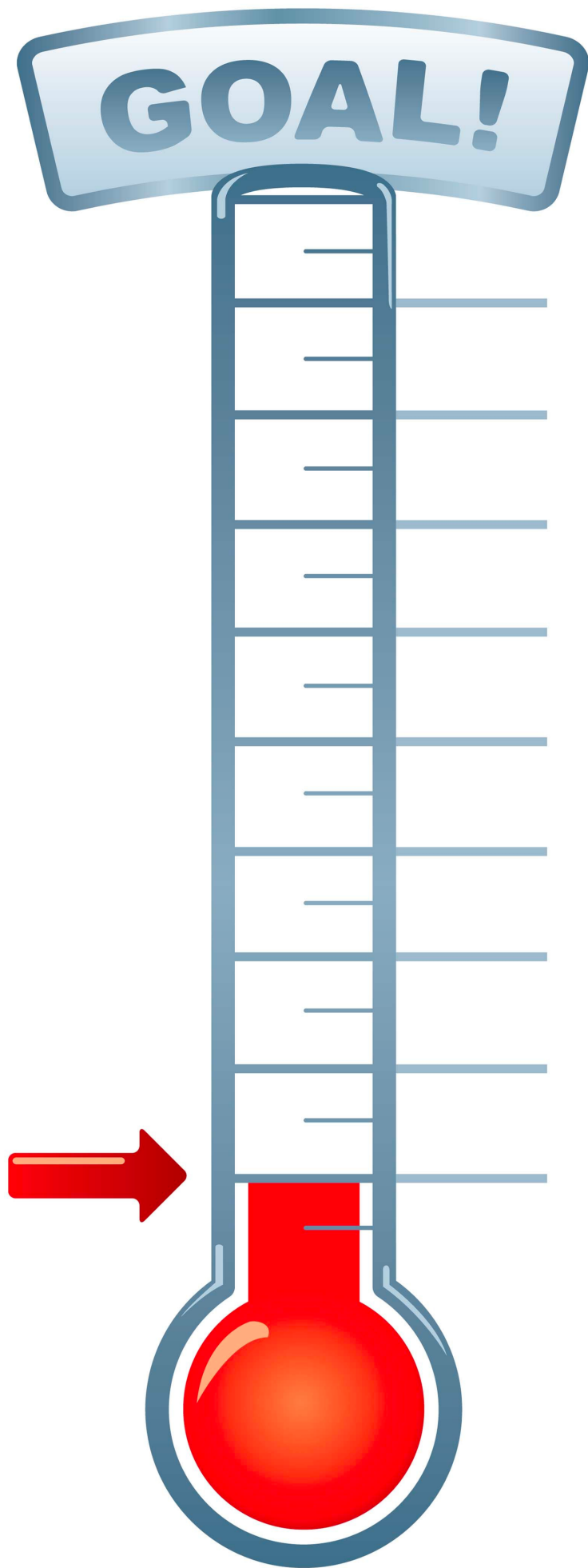
