Exceeding Predictions on the Algebra 1 Keystone Exam

SCHOOL PROFILE

Lancaster County, Pennsylvania

- ▶ Lampeter-Strasburg High School had an enrollment of 972 students in the 2020–2021 school year.
- ▶ Of the students in this Title I school, approximately 17% were minority or two or more races.
- ▶ Around 21% of the student body is economically disadvantaged and receives free or reduced-price lunches.

KEY EVIDENCE

Pilot GMM Cohort, 2013–2016



Almost **94% exceeded** their predicted score on the Pennsylvania Keystone Algebra 1 Exam.

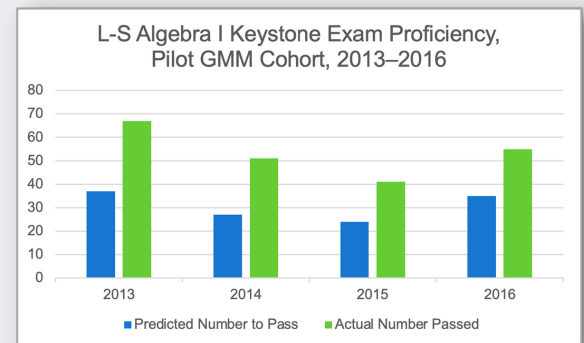


An astounding **73% more** students passed the Keystone Exam than were predicted to pass.



Lampeter-Strasburg High School achieved the **3rd highest** average growth index in the state in 2016.
