### SCHOOL PROFILE

Blair County, Pennsylvania

- For the 2016–2017 school year, Altoona Area High School had an enrollment of 1,770 students in grades 9–12.
- In 2017, the student body at Altoona Area High School was approximately 90% White and 8% Black.
- Approximately 41% of students were eligible for free and reduced-price lunch during the 2016–2017 school year.

### KEY EVIDENCE

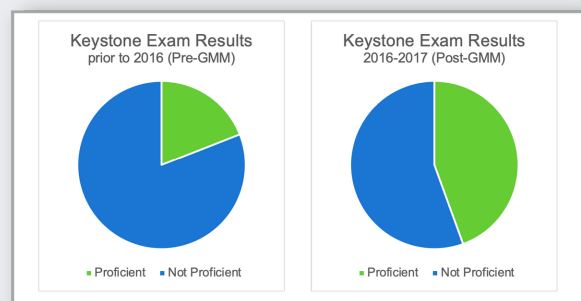
